Health & Safety Committee Report

NOTE: Hi again, health and safety Nelson Craig chair, Susie Lorch and Judy Holmgren. Stay tuned for more info from your new Health and Safety Committee. We are still looking for people interested in joining our team. We are also working on having guest speakers for about 1 hr. talks and informal lunch talks after the Friday lunches. Short topics about 30 minutes in length.

The purpose of the Bonfire Health & Safety Committee is to provide education and information to ensure the health and safety of all the residents of our community.

PROGRAMS TO KEEP US SAFE

Information courtesy of Bonfire Health & Safety Committee:

On February 21, a group of Bonfire residents enjoyed the first Lunch and Learn session arranged by the Health and Safety Committee. Ed and Victoria, two representatives from the Lake County Sheriff's Office provided very important and useful information on the programs offered to Lake County residents to keep us safe. Some of the programs are:

S LAKE COUNTY

VIAL OF LIFE

These vials are empty pill bottles containing a page that can provide pertinent medical information to emergency personnel in the event you cannot. You post a sticker on your door that tells responders that you have a vial which you have placed in the door of your refrigerator or on top of your refrigerator. Vials are located in the health and safety corner of the Clubhouse.

SAFETY NET

A radio transmitter bracelet for residents who suffer from cognitive disorders and are prone to wander. When the individual is missing, the caregiver immediately calls 911. The person's information is in the law enforcement computer and immediate response can begin. In Lake County, the time to find a person with this system is within 30 minutes.

To qualify for this program free, the following four criteria must be met:

- 1. The person must be a Lake County resident.
- 2. The person must have a full-time live-in caregiver.
- 3. The person must not drive.
- 4. There must be a note from a doctor diagnosing a cognitive disorder.

If your loved one does not meet all four criteria, you can still register them with the program at your cost, which is \$500.

LOCK BOX

The Lock Box Program is intended to provide Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) access to your residence in the event of an emergency where you are unable to open the door. A key to your residence will be stored in a secure metal storage device, similar to a realtor's lock box, near the entrance to your residence. The access code to the lock box will only be available to Police, Fire or EMS personnel and used only during an emergency.

SENIOR WATCH

If you live alone or have medical problems and have no one to check on you daily, this program will provide you with the security of knowing you won't be left for days in trouble. When you join, you will be assigned your own special identification number. Simply call the Senior Watch telephone operators each morning and tell them how you feel.

If the Senior Watch operators do not hear from you, they will attempt to call you. If you fail to answer the telephone, the Senior Watch will contact one of your neighbors or a relative, if possible, to check on you. If contact cannot be made with you in a timely manner, a Deputy Sheriff will be dispatched to your home. If there are topics you would like presented in future Lunch and Learn sessions, contact a member of the Health and Safety Committee.

MARCH EVENTS
