President's Report:

Dear Fellow Shareholders:

2024 has been quite a year for us. From the installation of the fiber optics project to dealing with Hurricane Milton - we have been very busy.

I want to personally say "thank you" to everyone in the park for helping to clean up and board up the grounds and damaged units. When the chips are down, we all come together.

A special "thank you" goes out to Joe Poglioli, our maintenance manager. He was on top of every situation and went above and beyond the "call of duty" to keep Bonfire operating.

Moving forward, we are looking at a new tree program for 2025 instituted by the state and Lake County. Details to follow in November.

People have been dumping debris in the compound and we are going to enforce the rules prohibiting this. The compound is being cleaned up at our expense; debris and anything unauthorized will be removed.

I remind everyone that yard waste and such is picked up by Lake County on Mondays. No dumping in the compound!

Golf carts are supposed to be parked on a pad or driveway. Too many carports in the park are full of "everything else" and there is no room for golf carts or autos to park in them. Parking in someone else's driveway without permission (and that permission is to be in writing and filed in the office), is prohibited.

Parking extra vehicles in our guest parking areas is also prohibited. That's what the compound spaces are for! Read and obey the rules!

The budget for 2025 will be coming up for review in November.
